## PSALMODY

### Psalm 30

**Antiphon:**

**Leader:** I cried to you, Lord, and you healed me;

**All:** I will praise you for ever.

**Leader:** I will praise you, Lord, you have rescued me \*  
and have not let my enemies rejoice over me.

**All:** O Lord, I cried to you for help \*  
and you, my God, have healed me.

O Lord, you have raised my soul from the dead, \*  
restored me to life from those who sink into the grave.

**Leader:** Sing psalms to the Lord, you who love him, \*  
give thanks to his holy name.

His anger lasts but a moment; his favor through life. \*  
At night there are tears, but joy comes with dawn.

**Antiphon:**

imputes no guilt, \*

in whose spirit is no guile.

**All:** I kept it secret and my frame was wasted. \*

I groaned all the day long

for night and day your hand \*

was heavy upon me.

Indeed, my strength was dried up \*

as by the summer's heat.

**Leader:** But now I have acknowledged my sins; \*  
my guilt I did not hide.  
I said: "I will confess \*  
my offense to the Lord."  
And you, Lord, have forgiven \*  
the guilt of my sin.

**All:** So let every good man pray to you \*  
in the time of need.  
The floods of water may reach high \*  
but him they shall not reach.  
You are my hiding place, O Lord; †  
you save me from distress. \*  
You surround me with cries of deliverance.

**Leader:** I will instruct you and teach you \*  
the way you should go;  
I will give you counsel \*  
with my eye upon you.

**All:** Be not like horse and mule, unintelligent, †  
needing bridle and bit, \*  
else they will not approach you.  
Many sorrows has the wicked †  
but he who trusts in the Lord, \*  
loving mercy surrounds him.

**Leader:** Rejoice, rejoice in the Lord, \*  
exult, you just!  
O come, ring out your joy, \*  
all you upright of heart.

and you that dwell therein!

### **READING**

for he has remembered his promise of mercy,  
the promise he made to our fathers, \*  
to Abraham and his children for ever.

**All:** Glory to the Father, and to the Son, \*  
and to the Holy Spirit:  
as it was in the beginning, is now, \*  
and will be for ever. Amen.

**Leader:** You are not yet fifty years old; how can you have seen Abraham?  
**All:** In very truth I tell you, before Abraham was, I AM.

## **INTERCESSIONS:**

**Leader:** Christ the Lord gave us a new commandment, of love for each other. Let us pray to him:

**All:** Lord, build up your people in love.

**Leader:** Good Master, teach us to love you in our neighbor,  
– and in serving them to serve you.

**All:** Lord, build up your people in love.

**Leader:** Light of the world, you gave light to the man born blind when he had washed in the pool of Siloam,

– enlighten catechumens through the water of baptism and the word of life.

**All:** Lord, build up your people in love.

**Leader:** Give to the dead the perfect joy of your eternal love,  
– and number us also among your chosen ones.

**All:** Lord, build up your people in love.

## **THE LORD'S PRAYER**

**Leader:** Remember us, Lord, when you come to your kingdom and teach us how to pray:)

Our Father, who art in heaven,  
hallowed be thy name;  
thy kingdom come;  
thy will be done on earth  
as it is in heaven.

as we forgive those who trespass against us;  
and lead us not into temptation,  
but deliver us from evil.
