Holy Spirit Novena for Pentecost 2023 St. Charles Borromeo Parish Friday, May 19 through Saturday, May 27, 2023 Nine days leading up to Pentecost Sunday, May 28

As we prepare for Pentecost, we invite you to join us in praying this Novena to the Holy Spirit. It begins with the same opening prayer each day, followed by a prayer that focuses on one of the fruits or gifts of the Holy Spirit. All are also welcome to join us praying it together at the start of our 5pm parish Zoom events this week: Monday and Wednesday Rosaries, and Friday Vespers. Zoom access information is available on the parish website and in the weekly parish email.

Each day, begin with this Opening Prayer to the Holy Spirit:¹

In the name of the Father, of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Most Holy Spirit, wash our hearts from pride and from all negative thoughts and actions. In Your mercy do not put us to the test, but forgive our sins. May Your protection allow us not to fail you.

Thank you for each one of Your wonderful spiritual gifts. We open our hearts to Your Fortitude, to face life and to bring forward Your Teachings and Your Love. We humbly ask for Your gift of Understanding, to grasp the truth in all things; to appreciate what is worthy, what is pleasing to you and helpful to all of your Creation.

With people who suffer everywhere, we plead to you: "Come Holy Spirit and fill the hearts of Humanity. Enkindle in us the fire of your Love. Send forth your Spirit and we shall be recreated and you will renew the face of the Earth."

Then recite the prayer for each day:²

Day 1 – Friday, May 19: Charity

Let us bow down in humility at the power and grandeur of the Holy Spirit. Let us worship the Holy Trinity and give glory today to the Paraclete, our Advocate. O Holy Spirit, by Your power, Christ was raised from the dead to save us all. By Your grace, miracles are performed in Jesus's name. By Your love, we are protected from evil.

And so, we ask with humility and a beggar's heart for Your gift of Charity within us. The great charity of all the host of Saints is only made possible by Your power, O Divine Spirit. Increase in us the virtue of charity,

That we may love as God loves, with the selflessness of the Saints.
